

Payment Options

With the introduction of Sentral Finance to our school, payment options are slightly different. Families may:

- Come into the office and pay in person
- Send cash/cheque in with your child
- When we receive your order we will send you a Payment Request via the Sentral app (or by email if you do not use the app). Payment can then be made via the app or clicking on the link in the email. Once payment is received the uniform will be sent home with your child.

Families wanting to try uniforms for sizing may come to the office either before or after school to do so. Uniform orders will be filled by office staff, usually within 2 days, and sent home with students.
