AIR CONDITIONING AND VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

As we advertised in last week's newsletter we are directing all voluntary contributions towards air-conditioning the Stage 1 rooms by the end of the year. We have so far had 20% of families pay their voluntary contributions and have \$2375 towards our \$15,000 target. This will be achieved with the remaining voluntary contributions coming in, further P & C fundraising and some school contribution. Some very generous families are making extra contributions which is certainly helping to increase our total.
