PSSA North Coast Athletics Carnival

North Haven's Lower North Coast athletics representatives performed extremely well at last Friday's North Coast carnival. The carnival was held in Lismore in usually hot conditions.

The stand out results for North Haven were Ethan Hensby's win in the 13 year 100m sprint and Adam Drewitt's 3rd placing in the 11 year shot put. Both these boys have been selected to represent the North Coast at the State Athletics carnival to be held at Homebush next term.

- Ethan improved his qualifying time of 14.95 sec to 14.07 to take out the final.
- Adam's qualifying distance was 8.94 m and at Lismore he threw 9.65 m to claim 3rd place.
- Isaac Luke jumped a personal best of 4.07 m in the Junior Boys long jump to claim 5th place.
- Zak Houston ran a swift 31.13 in his heat of the 11 year boys 200m.
- Noah Model overcame two fouls in the 11 year discus to land an impressive third throw.
- The senior boys 4 x 100m relay team of Max Eggert, Zak Houston, Ben Drewitt & Kye Tomlin just missed a place in the final and finished very strongly to run another impressive time.

Congratulations to all LNC athletes from North Haven and a special congratulations to North Coast representatives Ethan Hensby and Adam Drewitt.
